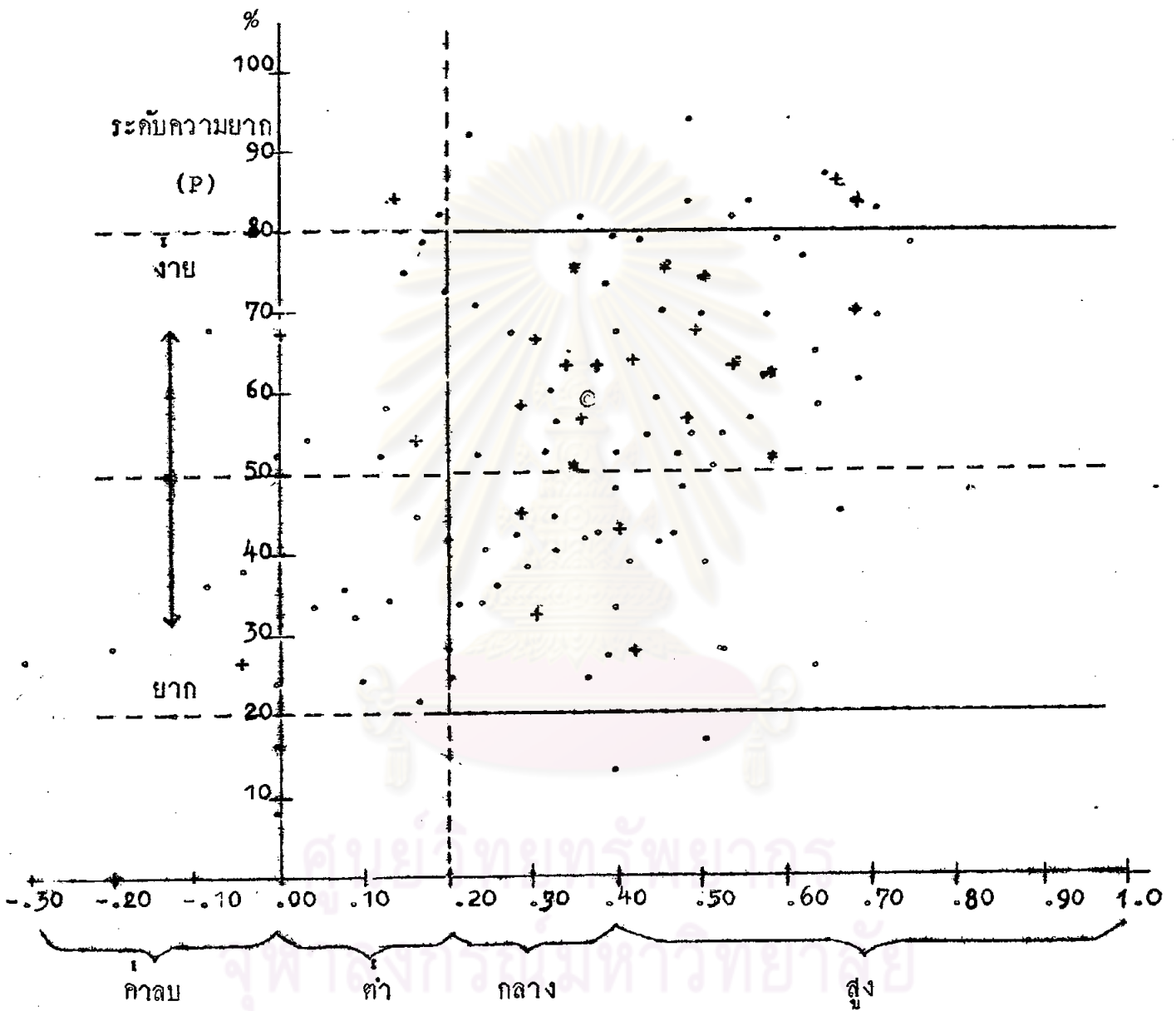

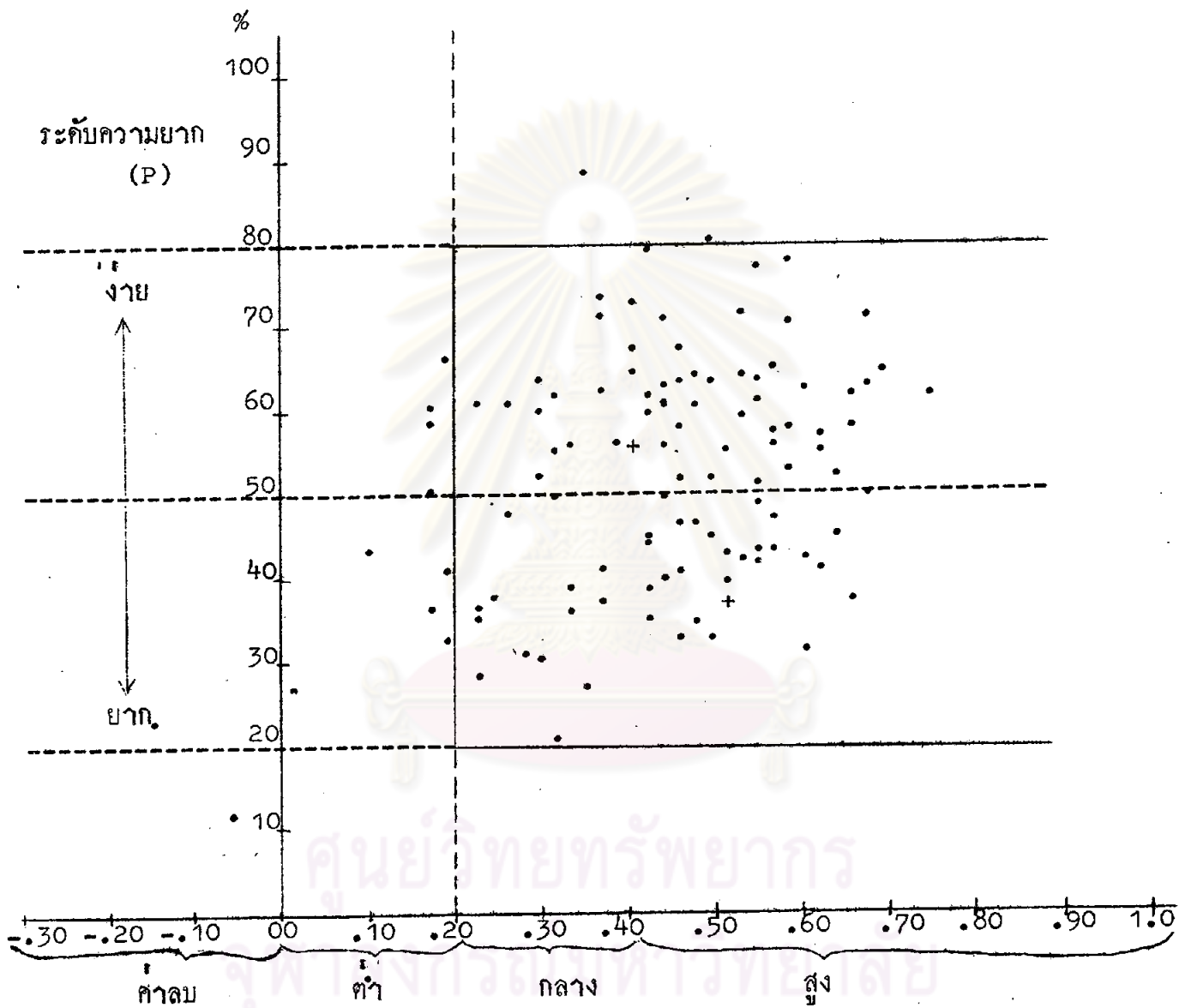
แผนภาพที่ 1 จุกกราฟแสดงคุณภาพของข้อสอบจากการทดลองสอบ
