

CHAPTER VIII

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR FUTURE WORK



From experience gained from conducting the study reported herein, the following recommendations for future studies are made.

1. Study should be made to determine the regression equation and the coefficient of correlation of each factor in each area. The objective of such study would be to find the relative relationship between each factor to the achievement of farmers.

2. Larger sample should be surveyed to determine the effect of financial affairs on the achievement of farmers. To obtain more confidence in the results, a simple field report form of farmers activities should be given to the farmers a year before the collection of data.

3. Study should be made to determine how the farm income was affected by each factor, and to evaluate the farm expenditure in each farm-income level to predict the maximum net farm income for that area.

4. Study should be made of a large sample of feeder roads in Thailand to determine the degree of influence of all significant factors on the achievement of farmers. Such a study would lead to the most economic solution for each particular area.
