CHAPTER VI

CONCLUSION

Hemorrhoidectomy under local perianal nerve block with 0.25 percent bupivacaine is feasible and safe. This technique has a high success rate and high level of satisfaction. Local anesthesia is lower cost, quicker anesthetic recovery, and fewer postoperative voiding problems. There was no significant difference in postoperative pain intensity between local anesthesia and spinal anesthesia. However, patients with local perianal block required less analgesic injections comparing to patients with spinal anesthesia.
