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

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### Appendix C

### Mann Whitney U Test

The Mann Whitney U Test is one of the statistical methods for comparing some certain characteristics of two independent sample groups. This statistics is applied to the data in forms of the ordinal scale and t-test parameters cannot be applied. Since the data when tested by normal curve distribution cannot be fitted, Mann Whitney U Test is used. T-test, on the other hand, can be applied only when the data is in forms of the interval scale or higher (Amnuay Lertchayantee, 1994).

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
