RECOMMENDATIONS

- i. Two microsatellite loci A88 and A14 are the excellent primers to study relatedness of A. dorsata colonies. Nevertheless, the locus B124 did give a single band readable bands which was difficult to score queen alleles.

 Therefore, it is recommended that the locus B124 should not be used in future work which is a waste of time and money.
- ii. In this study, I could not calculated distance travel by a swarm in order to resolve the question whether A. dorsata colonies take a long distance (Koeniger et al., 1980), it is recommended that in the future study colonies should mark and follow distance travel by the swarms.
- iii. Mapping of genes of A. dorsata that inspire the scout bees to select old nest site should be determined.
