BIOGRAPHY

Yuki Tamura Maki, Japanese born, moved to Sao Paulo, Brazil at the age of four where she stayed for eleven years. Relocated back to Tokyo to undertake her studies from High School through University. She attained Sophia University, Comparative Culture, and obtained a BA in Sociology in 1988.

In 1991, Ms. Maki took up residence in Jakarta, Indonesia for five years and transferred to Bangkok, Thailand in 1996. While residing in Bangkok, she enrolled in the Thai Studies program at Chulalongkorn University.
